**The College is required to report Graduation and Employment rates annually to the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC). In order to determine the cohort of students to report we allow a student 150% of the time a normal fulltime student would take to complete the program as published in the College Catalog. We do this by taking the program length and multiplying it by 1.5 to obtain the end date for the cohort and then add 12 months to determine the begin date for the cohort. We then add 3 months for the student to complete his/her job search. This worksheet summarizes the results as published in the 2022 ACCSC Annual Report for each program.
